


Submit a 3D print request to the MakerBot Innovation Center using PaperCut Job Ticketing



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

Step 1 — Log in to PaperCut Job Ticketing




- Open a web browser and go to https://go.umd.edu/submit.
- Use your Directory ID and password to log in.
- You will be brought to the PaperCut Job Ticketing order screen.

Step 2 — Start a MakerBot 5th Gen order



- Scroll down until you find the product [FDM] MakerBot 5th Gen. Click the green Start Order button when hovering over the product.
- Complete the order form and submit your order.
 - Be sure to include your part dimensions in the Additional instructions section on the order form.
 - Attach your files, provide a title for the order, specify color options, add notes, and optionally specify a due date.

Step 3 — Use PaperCut Job Ticketing to communicate with our staff



- While your order is processed, use PaperCut Job Ticketing to communicate with our staff.
- Click on an existing order at the bottom of your screen to open the detail view.
- Scroll to the bottom of the detail view to add comments to your order and communicate with our staff.

↑ Do not reply to emails from the system. They will not be associated with your order.

Step 4 — Pick up your completed job at the MIC



- You will receive emails to communicate the status of your print request.
- When your print has been completed, it will be available for pickup at the MakerBot Innovation Center in the TAP building.
- This part of the process remains the same for our customers.
