


Nozzle Clearing





Step 1 — Moving the Nozzle




- Move the nozzle, so that there is nothing below it
- Ideally the nozzle should be between the metal slats, if installed
- If you need further information on the location. Please refer to the link in the description.

Step 2 — **Preparing the Nozzle**




Make sure the splash guard is up.

Step 3 — **Preparing the Nozzle (Part 2)**




 Remove the garnet tube from the nozzle body.

Step 4 — Getting ready




- Close the Water jet cover
- proceed to the application on the laptop.

Step 5 — Navigating through the Protomax Software



 Click the test button on the console/home screen

Step 6 — Flush Plumbing



- Choose the "Flush Plumbing" option
- Continue to the next window

Step 7 — Flush Plumbing Part-2



- Start the process, by hitting the button shown.
- Wait for about 10 seconds, for it to flush any garnet left in the nozzle.
- After 10 seconds, go ahead and cancel the process.
